Pavement Preservation in Mora and San Miguel Counties
Work Beginning Tuesday, April 23

LAS VEGAS - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Four will begin pavement preservation operations on N.M. 94 starting Tuesday, April 23, 2024. Completion of this project is late Summer of this year. This preservation project will entail a Hot In-Place Recycling process beginning on N.M. 94 between mileposts 0 to 17. After the completion of N.M. 94, roadway systems N.M. 442, N.M. 121, and N.M. 105 will also be addressed.

Daily contractor hours of operation are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday with the possibility of weekend operations. A single-lane closure with a pilot car operation will be in place during working hours; minor delays are to be expected.

The NMDOT has required the implementation of a Fire Protection Plan for this project. This plan includes measures to prevent, respond to, and contain a fire produced during construction operations.
